

Bloomberg Politics – Purple Slice Poll Married Women Voters Conducted by Purple Strategies Survey Topline April 2016

METHODOLOGY

Purple Insights conducted 912 interviews of married women who are likely 2016 general election voters, including an oversample of Republican presidential primary voters, between April 5 and 10, 2016. The poll was conducted online, using an opt-in nationally representative panel.

- 603 general election voters (MoE: +/- 4.0%, at the 95% confidence level)
- 513 Republican primary voters (MoE: +/-4.3%, at the 95% confidence level)
