Description of Occurrence

On 1/7/2024 at approximately 2201hrs, Judge Tanya Chutkan called (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) and stated that she had Metropolitan Police for the District of Columbia at her house. The Judge stated that she was alright, and that she had been a victim of a 'swatting call.' The Judge handed her phone over to (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) who further explained to (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) that MPDC dispatch had received just past 2200hrs an emergency call where the caller stated that a male shot a female at (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F). (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) explained that MPDC responded to the call in force (b)(7)(E).

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) explained that there was a second call to MPDC dispatch for (b)(6); (b)(7)(C). MPDC had responded to both calls, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C). (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) stated that there would be a report of the incident under (b)(7)(E). team members arrived on scene at approximately 2245 (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F).

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) contacted (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) and informed the Chief of the incident. MPDC Officers left the scene shortly after arrival by the (b)(7)(E) team. (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) requested that a copy of the report be sent after completion (b)(7)(E). (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) also requested (b)(7)(E).
