


# How do China's Provinces Compare with the World?

Bloomberg calculated Chinese provincial GDP per capita to be ranked together with that of economies around the world, based on IMF data released in April, 2018. Here's how they stack up.

Notes: Regional Chinese GDP per capita approximated by dividing the total preliminary nominal provincial GDP, as of Dec. 31, 2017, by total population, as of year-end 2016; assumed conversion rate was 3.849 Chinese yuan = 1 international dollar, the implied rate between 58,417: 2017 Chinese GDP per capita in local currency and \$15,175, in purchasing power parity (2011 constant international dollar terms); only included economies with at least 3 million population.
