

Dear Marty,

(Pages ① + ② are in your bathroom)

- 1) The purple and pink hanging impatiens go hang from wall between den and dining area flanking symmetrically the plant that already hangs there. The pink one hangs closer to first place (matching the pinwheel bread man there). The purple is currently hanging from your exercise bike and the pink is in the box next to it.

- 2) The hanging nasturtium (long orange) and the hanging red begonia (^{violet}) go in the master bath. The begonia aligns with the pink plant and divides the remaining space. The nasturtium does the same on the perpendicular line.
i.e. looking down




(iso splits distance to skylite)

Both hooks should be parallel to wall with previous hooks (i.e. current pink & green)

It's lower right corner should be defined by the light switch bottom and the thermostat right side



~~④~~ Butterfly w flowers goes above shower

~~⑤~~ The sign over front door isn't centered. Align it w the inner door

~~⑥~~ Re-center the hair cut sign (^{your} ~~bathroom~~) so it aligns w the right sink like

~~⑦~~ I placed the scale and drew an outline of Mickey's ears on the wall


~~⑧~~ Return a) In the Host of the Nite b) door chimes c) Magic tricks (we have it) (don't work) (did we order it?)

~~⑪~~ Put the woodpecker door knock on divider between window and front door centered at level of his & her planters





I have spent more time in your bathroom this weekend than you have in your life, so let's start there.

- ~~1) Hair cut sign still needs to be moved (approx 1") to the right top~~
~~2) Put up the circle butterflies so their height aligns with the top of the condensers over the toilet equally spaced over the width of the tank. (Keep the one you broke on the extreme left.)~~
~~3) Put up the smaller of the muscle bars go the top of the muscle brackets aligns at the same height, bisecting the space between the tank and the mirror. (scale cord goes behind bar.)~~

This will hold your face towel (also butterfly). thus you have one continuous line



- ~~4) Put up the shell/mirror tissue box horizontally bisecting the toilet tank so the top aligns with top of Mickey's ears This will create a second higher line (B)~~




5) Put up larger towel bar over toilet paper holder (next to shower) symmetrically horizontally at aforementioned height (B) (i.e. top of brackets at line (B))

(top of frame (G)) Put up June 22, 1986 picture on same wall at same height (B) dividing space between towel bar and Mickey wall. Thus the (B) line will wrap around from shower to mirror.

7) Put up Marty-Twins picture at same height (B) (i.e. top of frame at height (B)) on wall opposite shower. Picture should divide space between end of mirror and edge of open door. i.e. Three walls opened up would look like:



(8) The two muscle hooks go on the door, splitting it into thirds. The top of the bracket should align with the top of the shower at cresting > new hipster line (C) for the ^{closed} door wall only. i.e.


