This is the final response to your June 13, 2023, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Federal Protective Service (FPS). You are seeking the following:

1. Emails, photographs, videos, memos, text messages, letters, directives, and intelligence bulletins and assessments, suspicious activity reporting, open source intelligence/social media monitoring reports, Threat Assessments, Patriot Reports, Situation Reports. prepared, drafted or disseminated by the DHS components this request is addressed to referencing the Justice Department's indictment and the arrest and arraignment of former President Donald Trump at the Wilkie D. Ferguson Jr. U.S. Courthouse in Miami, Florida, on June 13, 2023.

2. The same types of records described in part 1 referencing the planning and staging of protests, demonstrations and civil disobedience at the Wilkie D. Ferguson Jr. U.S. Courthouse over the Department of Justice's indictment of former President Donald Trump.

To provide you with the greatest degree of access authorized by law, DHS has considered your request under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552. A search of DHS's Federal Protective Service for documents responsive to your request produced a total of 113 pages. I have determined that six pages are released in their entirety, 76 pages are partially releasable, and 31 pages are withheld in their entirety pursuant to Title 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(6), (b)(7)(C), and (b)(7)(E), FOIA Exemptions 6, 7C, and 7E.

Enclosed are 82 pages with certain information withheld as described below:

FOIA Exemption 6 exempts from disclosure personnel or medical files and similar files the release of which would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This requires a balancing of the public's right to disclosure against the individual's right to privacy. *[The types of documents and/or information that we have withheld may consist of birth certificates, naturalization certificates, driver license, social security numbers, home addresses, dates of birth, or various other documents and/or information belonging to a third party that are considered personal.]* The privacy interests of the individuals in the records you have requested outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into the aforementioned balancing test.

Pursuant to DHS Instruction 262-11-004, FOIA Officers at DHS have been instructed to withhold personally identifiable information (PII) and sensitive personally identifiable information (SPII) of DHS personnel unless a determination is made that the disclosure does not raise security or privacy concerns, or if those concerns are outweighed by any public interest in that information. [This policy is available online](#). Under this policy, the names of senior leaders, spokespersons, and political appointees are generally releasable. With respect to this FOIA request, DHS applied FOIA Exemption 6 to protect PII of DHS employees, including names and contact information. To the extent that DHS has withheld employee PII within these records, it has been determined that the employee(s) has/have substantial and legitimate privacy interests and that these interests are not outweighed by any public interest in the operations of the Department.

FOIA Exemption 7(C) protects records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes that could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. This exemption takes particular note of the strong interests of individuals, whether they are suspects, witnesses, or investigators, in not being unwarrantably associated with alleged criminal activity. That interest extends to persons who are not only the subjects of the investigation, but those who may have their privacy invaded by having their identities and information about them revealed in connection with an investigation. Based upon the traditional recognition of strong privacy interest in law enforcement records, categorical withholding of information that identifies third parties in law enforcement records is ordinarily appropriate. As such, I have determined that the privacy interest in the identities of individuals in the records you have requested clearly outweigh any minimal public interest in disclosure of the information. Please note that any private interest you may have in that information does not factor into this determination.

FOIA Exemption 7(E) protects records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the release of which would disclose techniques and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law.


While an adequate search was conducted, you have the right to appeal the above withholding determination. Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 90 days of the date of this letter, to: Privacy Office, Attn: FOIA Appeals, U.S. Department of Homeland Security, 2707 Martin Luther King Avenue SE, Mail Stop 0655, Washington, D.C. 20528-0655, following the procedures outlined in the DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5 § 5.8. Your envelope and letter should be marked "FOIA Appeal." Copies of the FOIA and DHS FOIA regulations are available at www.dhs.gov/foia.

Provisions of the FOIA allow DHS to recover part of the cost of complying with your request. In this instance, because the cost is below the \$25.00 minimum, there is no charge.

You may contact the DHS FOIA Public Liaison at 202-343-1743 or toll free 1-866-431-0486 for any further assistance and to discuss any aspect of your request. Additionally, you have a right to seek dispute resolution services from the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) which mediates disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies as a non-exclusive alternative to litigation. If you are requesting access to your own records (which is considered a Privacy Act request), you should know that OGIS does not have the authority to handle requests made under the Privacy Act of 1974. In anticipation for the potential of violence and damage to federal property, the Federal Protective Service (FPS) will deploy to Miami, Florida to support federal, state and local law enforcement to prevent, protect, respond to potential criminal acts, and other hazards threatening the U.S. Government's property and critical infrastructure.

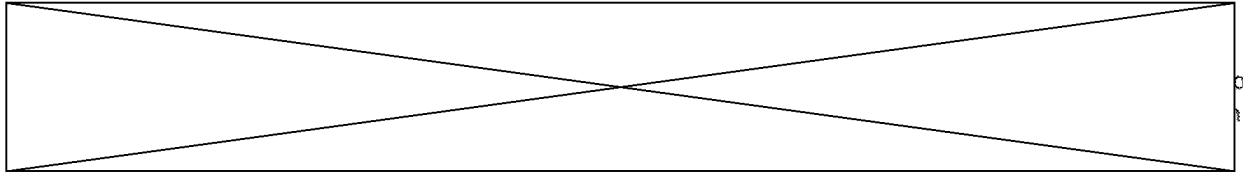

~~(U//FOUO)~~ **Overview:** Former President (FPOTUS) Donald Trump has been indicted by a federal grand jury in connection with his alleged mishandling of more than 100 classified documents. FPOTUS Trump faces seven counts on charges that are reported to include false statements, obstruction, and at least one violation of the Espionage Act. The investigation began last year when the National Archives alerted the FBI that government documents FPOTUS Trump had returned after having been out of office for about a year included 184 that were marked classified. FPOTUS Trump has denied any wrongdoing. It is reported that he is to show up for a hearing at 1500 on June 13, 2023, at the Wilkie Ferguson (FL0010) Courthouse in Miami Florida, located at 400 N Miami Ave., Miami, FL 33128.

- **(b)(7)(E)** Update 1 – 1211 - There was a television discovered strapped to a light pole on the sidewalk in front of the Wilkie D. Ferguson, Jr. courthouse. The City of Miami PD responded and requested the assistance FPS ECDT (K9 **(b)(6),(b)(7)(C)**). At the completion of investigative actions, the scene was declared safe, the television removed, and normal operations resumed. There are currently approximately 150 protesters and 300 media personnel on site at the Wilkie D. Ferguson, Jr. courthouse.

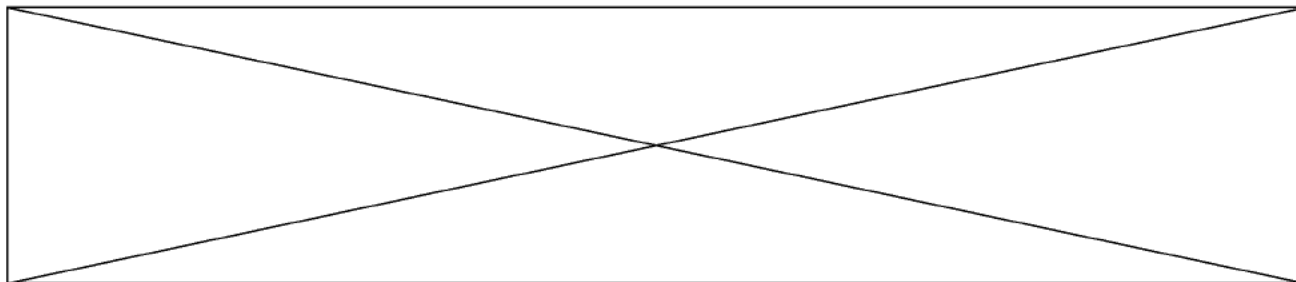

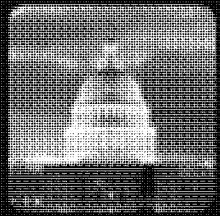

Good afternoon sir, please see below for an update on the coordination efforts for the security of the Miami US Courthouse:

Beginning at noon on Saturday, June 10, 2023, FPS, US Marshals Service (USMS), City of Miami Police Department (MPD), and the Miami-Dade County Police Department (MDPD) initiated an increased security posture at the Miami US

Courthouse consisting of Officers conducting increased patrol operations, including Explosive Detection Canine sweeps at and adjacent to the Miami USCH, and FPS

FPS Region 4 has also increased patrol operations at the FBI Miami Field Office (2030 SW 145th Avenue, Miramar, FL), and the Resident Agency (RA) locations in West Palm Beach and Fort Pierce, FL. FPS does not expect any disruptive activity at the Key West nor the Homestead RA's but will (b)(7)(E) and respond accordingly.

Additionally, FPS has increased patrol operations at the other FBI Field Offices around the country to detect and deter criminal activity and will increase patrol operations at other federal facilities based on (b)(7)(E)

An initial walk through of the security preparations was conducted by FPS, USMS, USSS, MPD, and MDPD on Sunday, June 11, 2023.

FPS established and locked down the security perimeter of the Miami USCH at 8:00AM this morning, allowing only authorized personnel access through the perimeter.

A second walk-through with FPS, USMS, USSS, MPD, and MDPD, took place at 1PM today to make any necessary adjustments to the security planning efforts.

The MPD has established a location for First Amendment activity and a separate location for the media to stage. These locations are on the North Miami Avenue side of the Miami USCH, off federal property, and outside the perimeter security barriers that encompass the Miami USCH. These areas will be marked, monitored, and controlled by the MPD. MPD will ensure that counter-protest groups are separate from each other and will maintain a clear path on the sidewalks and vehicle entrance/exit points.

On Tuesday, June 13, 2023, approximately (b)(7)(E) Law Enforcement Officers will be assigned to the Miami USCH:

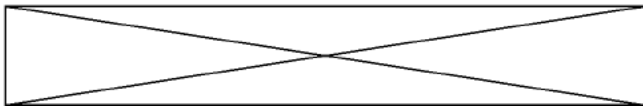

It is reported that he is to show up for a hearing at 1500 on June 13, 2023, at the Wilkie Ferguson (b)(7)(E) Courthouse in Miami Florida, located at 400 N Miami Ave., Miami, FL 33128.

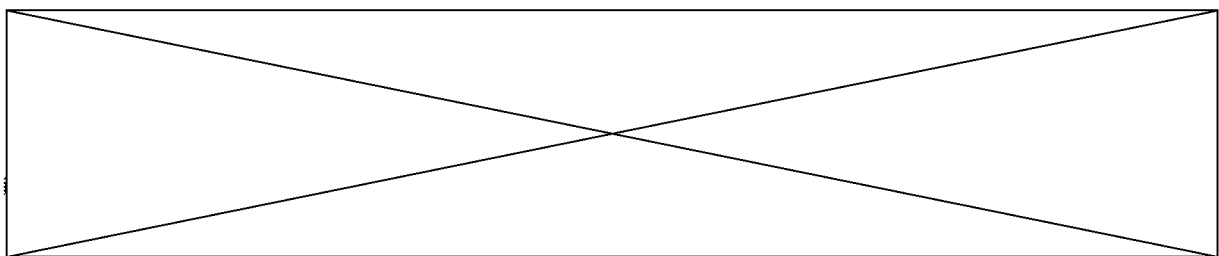

The investigation began last year when the National Archives alerted the FBI that government documents FPOTUS Trump had returned after having been out of office for about a year included 184 that were marked classified.
