












I know, I'm a broken record about this. But it's important. Here's what I'd hope to see you put out:

You already know that seniors and people with compromised health are at greater risk from COVID19. Do you know how much greater? Of the 5,600 who have died worldwide, 94% were 70 or older. This disease kills seniors and compromised persons and very few young people.

We seniors are also the ones who will overwhelm the hospitals if we get the virus. If we keep our infection rate down, hospitals will be able to care for the few of us who get























We seniors are also the ones who will overwhelm the hospitals if we get the virus. If we keep our infection rate down, hospitals will be able to care for the few of us who get Covid19–saving lives.

So in all likelihood, we seniors and compromised need to take far more restrictive measures than we are right now. Here's a list for such individuals or couples:

1) strict quarantine. Stay in your home, drive alone in your car, or walk by yourselves outdoors where others aren't around. No exceptions. No restaurants, no movies, no shopping, no airplanes, no going to work.
























- 2) prepare your own meals at home. If you order delivered meals, make sure to heat them to kill any viruses that preparers may have left behind.
- 3) ask younger friends, neighbors or church members to do your shopping for you. Have them leave items at your door. Call this person for anything you may need.
- 4) if you share your home with younger people, divide your quarantine space by creating a barrier with anything you can find, and keep younger folks several feet away from the dividing line.












