NEW V2 API FILTERING OPTION

• Unlisted Instruments:

Ability to return inactive FIGIs assigned to an equity instrument.

Option Type:

Derivative option type (call or put).

Strike Price:

The strike price is defined as the price at which the holder of an option can buy or sell the underlying security when the option is exercised.

Contract Size:

Number of shares that can be exchanged for each option contract exercised.

Coupon Range:

Current interest rate of the security.

Expiration Date:

The last day (in the case of or the only day on which an option may be exercised.

Maturity Date:

Date the principal of a security is due and payable.
